### 1984

PC Plus, the precursor to Dynamics NAV, was introduced

Dynamics NAV 2009 introduced a major rewrite of the product

### 2013

Dynamics NAV 2013 R2 followed.

Dynamics NAV 2018 marked the final iteration of the NAV brand

Microsoft rebranded Navision to Dynamics NAV

### 2016





### <sup>02</sup> Scalable throughput






- ♣ 600 web service requests per user
  - previous 5-minute sliding window
- ♣ 5 concurrently running scheduled tasks per user



- ❖ 10 Million API calls in a day
- \* 1 Million API calls in an hour
  - \* 277 per second on average
- \* 25,000 API calls in a minute
  - \* 416 per second on average
